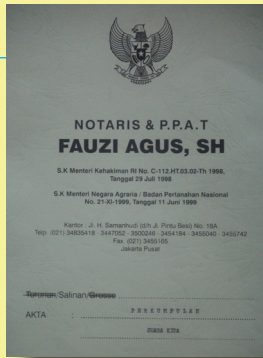
Sejarah **Suara Kita**

Suara Kita adalah organisasi perjuangan kesetaraan dan keadilan bagi kelompok lesbian, gay, biseksual dan transgender (LGBT) melalui media-informasi-kebudayaan untuk memberikan rasa aman, kesenangan, tempat pengetahuan sekaligus bertemu teman agar menjadi diri sendiri. Suara Kita berdomisili di Jakarta tetapi wilayah kerja seluruh Indonesia.

Fokus isu Suara Kita berkaitan dengan isu politik, demokrasi, hak asasi manusia, pluralism yang dikaitkan dengan seksualitas. Berdirinya Suara Kita di inisiasi oleh beberapa orang gay di Jakarta pada September 2007 yang awalnya bernama Our Voice. Pada 23 September 2013, Suara Kita telah disahkan di Kementerian Hukum Dan Hak Asasi Manusia Nomor AHU – 185.AH.01.07.Tahun 2013, melalui akte notaris Fauzi Agus,SH Nomor 47 tanggal 21 Mei 2013.

History of **Suara Kita**

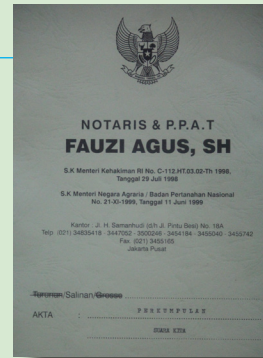
The ongoing need for discussing LGBT-related (lesbian, gay, bisexual and transgender) issues pertaining to political and human rights issues (beside health issue) encouraged us to establish Suara Kita.

Suara Kita was initiated by several LGBT individuals in Jakarta in September 2007.

Suara Kita is an LGBT equality and advocacy organization on the basis of critical ideology using information media as its communication channel and provides security, contentment, knowledge as well as a gathering place and where LGBT individuals can fully express themselves.

4. **and Harry Kurniawan**, adolescent program executive officer at Perhimpunan Keluarga Berencana Indonesia.

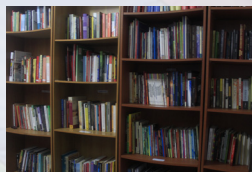
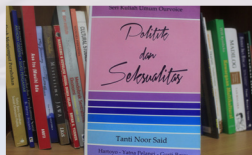

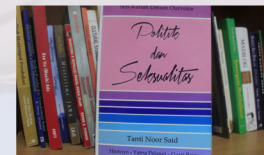
